Grow Hope Maritime Project – NS farmers “Grow Hope” by growing and selling crops to end global hunger. Orchard Valley can get involved by sponsoring an acre of corn for \$300. This will help cover the cost of growing the corn. Each \$300 per acre can grow to \$750 per acre of corn when sold, and then will be matched by the government to realize a \$3,000 contribution to Food Aid in developing countries. The Church Council will match the OVUC congregational donations received for the Grow Hope Project during this month. Envelopes are available for your donation; OVUC will issue tax receipts. This project will run for the month of May.
