Whenever you drink it, remember me."

One: We drink this to remember Jesus.

Two: What do we remember at this table?

One: We remember Jesus' death and celebrate his

resurrection;

we await with hope his coming again to bring peace and justice to the earth; and we proclaim the mystery of our faith:

Affirmation of Memory and Hope:

All: Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.

All: For whom do we pray at this table?

One: We pray for God's world

Prayer of Transformation / Blessings of the Elements:

One: Send, O God,

your Holy Spirit upon us and upon these gifts,

that all who share in this bread and cup

may be the body of Christ: light, life, and love in the world.
