## **Old Business-**

- **1. Stoves-** Older model stove sold for \$15.00. Newer one stored in shed for possible future use or to be sold later.
- 2. CPR Course- completed
- **3. Gravel for parking lot-** Job completed and note of thanks sent to Doug Hennigar by Norma for spreading it.
- 4. Congregational Life Supper- The Property Committee have volunteered to assist with the preparation of one meal on the last Tuesday of a month. Dates have been filled so will try for next year.
