WORLD COMMUNION SUNDAY: This Sunday, we will be joining churches around the world in celebrating the Holy Communion together during our 10am service. If you are watching on the livestream, have your bread/cracker and juice of choice with you as we remember Jesus as he feasted with his friends.

Every Child Matters -- The number of human remains found at residential schools has gone from 215 children to over 1,000 so far. As we wait and pray for Canada's indigenous peoples to be able to engage us in dialogue again, we have set up a physical memorial by tying orange ribbons on our signs and placing an orange T-shirt, children's shoes and children's socks at the entrance sign. Orange is the colour of reconciliation and the colour of the Orange Shirt Society who supports Indian residential school reconciliation: they have given us permission to use their slogan "Every Child Matters".

We invite you to place children's shoes at the entrance sign, children's socks on the clothesline along our parking lot and/or something orange where people passing your home can see it (trail tape around a pole or tree, a shirt or sign on an exterior door or window, etc.) Socks may be donated to families afterwards; shoes will not. Contact Katie or Don if you'd like to read one of the resources we have regarding Truth and Reconciliation. (Note the green ribbons on our signs are to remember the Muslim family killed in June and to show solidarity against Islamophobia.
