Kentville Interchurch Council forwarded this urgent notice:

We are assisting the Immigrant Settlement Staff, YREACH Program (Recognizing Enhancing Aligning Community Horizons) in the search for a home for a **family of 10** that will be homeless at the end of May.

The home they were renting in Kentville was sold and they have been evicted because the new owners want to live there. They have lived in Canada for about 5 years and were a refugee family originally.
