Voyagers: During Worship Service. As part of our creation season, for the next four weeks, we are doing a fundraiser for the *World Wildlife Foundation*! Mystery Friends is an anonymous pen pal program where a member of the youth in the congregation is partnered with an adult in the congregation for four weeks. They write letters using their secret codenames for the first three weeks about hobbies, life, school, work. They either Email their letter by Saturday evening to youth.ovuc@gmail.com to be printed off on Sunday OR write a handwritten letter to be left on the table to be picked up. There will be two tables set up in the sanctuary, one to receive letters for the Jr. members and the other where letters for the Sr Mystery Friend may be dropped off. Following church the juniors check the Jr. Table to see if they got anything from their Sr. Mystery Friend, and the seniors check their table. Then the pairs all meet on the fifth week at our Santa Claus Celebration held before the white gift service! You will be contacted the week before mystery friends with your codenames!

Getting to Know You *small dinner groups -* late in 2019, Congregational Life Committee offered to connect folks interested in getting to know each other more deeply into small dinner groups. All was set and then the Pandemic arrived before this initiative ever got up and running. Most folks that originally signed up have been contacted to confirm their interest (apologetically, some may have been missed). A lot of time has passed and we have some new folks, some folks have moved away, etc. So, we begin again!!

How it can work - folks put their name forward to participate (singles or couples). Congregational Life will randomly put small groups together (no more than 6). Each group will then be on their own to organize how they wish to proceed within their dinner group. The idea is that each "household" will take a turn hosting a dinner. The host will determine the menu and prepare/provide the main food item. The other group members will contribute something else from the menu as their contribution. The plan is that the meal preparation is not onerous on any one person or household. Truth be told, once the groups are set, feel free to go rogue and agree to do your own thing! We only want to facilitate opportunities for people from the church family to get to know each other more meaningfully. This first round should last approximately 6 months. That should be a dinner a month on average. When round one is complete, anyone wanting to continue participating can go for another round and be set within a different group of folks. Congregational Life Committee is happy to facilitate the group making!
