Musique Royale: Duo Oriana (How Like A Golden Dream)

This August, Musique Royale welcomes Duo Oriana to perform a concert tour entitled "How Like A Golden Dream", featuring soprano Sinead White and lutenist Jonathan Stuchbery in six historic venues across Nova Scotia. The repertoire featured comes from their recently released through Leaf Music, where the music traverses the sacred and the secular; with 17th-century hymns and antiphons from the Office of Hours, sung at Vespers and Compline in monasteries and Irish folk songs influenced by Celtic missionaries. Concerts take place in Parrsboro, Johnstown, Wolfville, Mahone Bay, Crousetown, and Pictou, with the final two concerts being performed as solo lute concerts by Jonathan Stuchbery.
